CALL TO ORDER

The Bank of the San Juan's checking account had a balance of \$127,813.36, with a total balance of \$139,383.95. The Board reviewed line items and payments made.

<u>Street Signs</u>—A proposal to share the cost of new street signs with the Loma Linda Homeowners Association was tabled until the Board hears from the Association.

<u>Road Status and Maintenance</u>—Matt Fischer and Rick Sautel made a presentation with photos depicting their concerns regarding excessive material removal along some areas of roads throughout Loma Linda. The Board had reviewed their initial concerns with Tracy Smith, and after discussing this with the Contractor, the Board was not overly concerned. The last grading involved the loss of the grader (midplowing) due to transmission failure and was completed with a different plow and driver.

The Board reviewed and approved a resolution for exemption from audit. The resolution was approved and adopted by all members.
